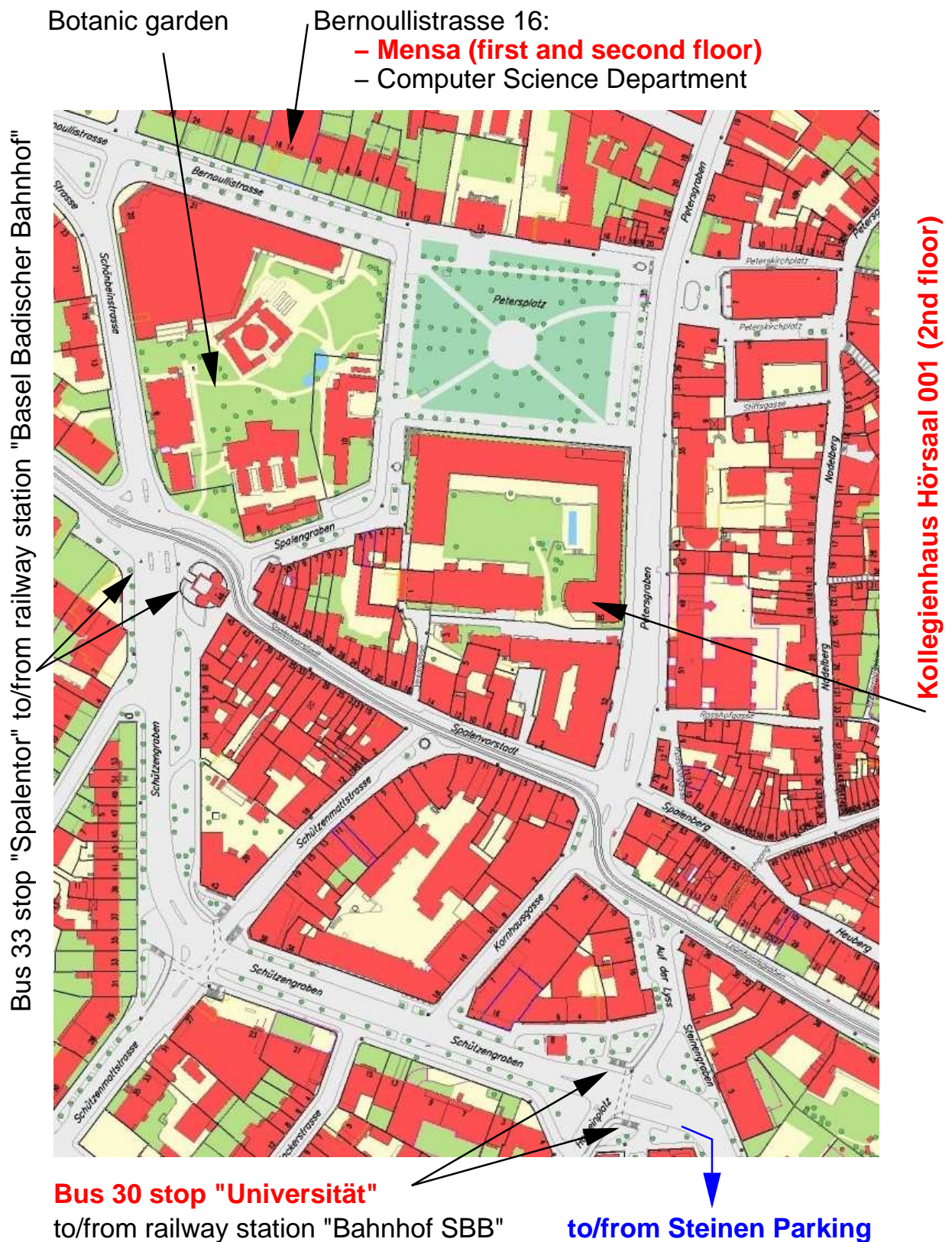

## Travel instructions - Train

The University is conveniently reachable from the railway station “Bahnhof SBB” with bus # 30. This bus leaves every 7 minutes in front of the railway station (Cafe Bachmann) and takes 3 minutes to reach the stop “Universität”. Price (take a short distance ticket): Fr 1.90, or Fr 1.40 with half fare card.

## Travel instructions - Car

Public parking lots are not easily available in the vicinity of the Kollegienhaus. However, there is a underground parking facility “Steinen” within 10 minutes walking distance. From the A2 motorway (Bern, Zürich), take exit #10 “Basel Süd/City”, follow the sign “Universitätsspital/Spalentor”, turn left to follow the arrow “P Steinen/Heuwaage”. Map for the Steinen parking:
